

» DATRI'S blood stem cell donor drive from Monday

CHENNAI: India's largest blood stem cell donors' registry DATRI, on Sunday announced a week-long nation-wide donor campaign "Get Set Go Orange" from Monday to mark the World Cancer Day. People suffering from Acute Myeloid Leukaemia (AML) and Acute Lymphoblastic Leukaemia (ALL) were looking for potential donors. But only one in 10,000 and one in two
