#### **Celebrating International Volunteer Day with DATRI**

Every year on December 5th, International Volunteer Day honors the dedication of volunteers worldwide. Established by the United Nations in 1985, this day highlights the invaluable contributions of volunteers in promoting peace, sustainability, and development. It serves as a call for individuals and organizations to take action on global challenges, from environmental issues to health crises.

This year, DATRI, India's leading Blood Stem Cell Donors Registry, joins the celebration by emphasizing the critical role of volunteers in healthcare and stem cell donation. DATRI's mission is to increase the donor registry to give blood cancer and severe blood disorder patients a chance at life through life-saving stem cell transplants.

#### Why Volunteer with DATRI?

Moreover, Volunteers can make interested people to register as a potential stem cell donor via DATRI's online platform.
- 3. **Supporting Fundraising Initiatives:** The cost of maintaining and growing the registry is significant and volunteers play a key role in DATRI's fundraising events. Fundraising primarily enables DATRI to organize more drives, recruit more donors, and provide more patients suffering from blood cancers and other blood related disorders with a second chance at survival.
- 4. **Counselling to donors:** Volunteers can also provide counselling support to donors and their families by offering clear information, addressing concerns & fear, explaining the impact, providing encouragement to newly identified donor. This human connection helps the donor to build confidence and a sense of compassion around the cause.

5. **Social media support & writing Blogs:** Starting from following, liking, sharing and commenting on posts to boost visibility for DATRI's social media platforms to create captivating reels, informative content and Writing impactful blogs to raise awareness about the importance of stem cell donation Volunteers can strengthen the social media efforts of DATRI.

#### How to Get Involved with DATRI


- **Sign Up as a Volunteer:** Visit DATRI's website to sign up and get information on upcoming events and opportunities.








- Upload passport size photo & Aadhaar card or any other Gov ID proof & your signature.(File size should be less than 1 MB. If your file size is high, try to compress or take a screenshot and upload).
- Once you've filled out the form, click on the check boxes, click on the Non-disclosure agreement, read, agree & Close. Now click on the Captcha and Submit the form.
- Then the Volunteer Manager will get in touch with you for further engagement.
