





Second Security of Control Security 2024: A STORY OF VISION, GRIT, AND HEART

This year, Kerala created history by recording the highest number of donor registrations across India—a remarkable milestone that speaks volumes about vision, dedication, and teamwork.

At the helm of this incredible journey was Athulya, whose passion and perseverance transformed an ambitious dream into a life-saving reality. With the unwavering support of Ratheesh and Udhayan, and under the wise mentorship of Aby, the Kerala team proved what's possible when strategy meets heart.



The goal was bold—12,000 donor registrations in a year. That meant 1,000 donors every month, an ambitious target that called for adaptability and precision. Athulya and her team adopted flexible а game plan-anticipating that some months would be slow, they maximized efforts durina high-opportunity windows. Educational institutions across Kerala became central to this strategy. By aligning recruitment activities with academic calendars, they ensured that every moment on campus was

leveraged to its fullest. Simultaneously, public drives anchored in patient stories created strong emotional resonance, driving both awareness and action.

A key factor in their success was the use of repeat drives with institutions that hosted donor events annually or biennially. These trusted partnerships helped the team anchor their KPIs and provided consistency throughout the year.

But numbers weren't achieved by comfort zones alone. Breaking into new territories involved persistent outreach—cold calls, community networking, and countless follow-ups. While these efforts often came with rejections, every new lead opened doors to new opportunities and fresh registrations.

Among the most moving aspects of the year were patient-led campaigns. Raw, urgent, and deeply human, these campaigns turned stories into action, igniting participation from families, friends, and entire neighbourhoods. A handful of such efforts played a powerful role in building momentum and reminding everyone of the life-or-death importance of stem cell donation.





One of the most magical parts of Athulya's iourney was her "Bucket List of Manifestation"—a personal wishlist of locations and organizations she hoped to engage. One standout success District, was Kannur which started with modest engagement but soon flourished. Through counselling sessions and genuine community interest, it quickly evolved into one of the year's strongest contributors.

Another driver of sustained momentum was the practice of revisiting institutions with inspiring stories—updates about successful donations, life-changing transplants, and messages of gratitude from recipients. These stories kept the spirit of the mission alive, creating an emotional loop that fuelled continued participation.

Athulya's journey was nothing short of transformative. With meticulous planning, people-first outreach, and a mission-driven mindset, she and her team didn't just hit the target—they redefined what's possible. With the combined energy of Ratheesh, Udhayan, and Aby, this year stands as a beacon of what's achievable when passion meets purpose.

POWERING HOPE: 42 LIVES TOUCHED THROUGH TEAMWORK IN AP & TELANGANA

In the financial year 2024–2025, 233 stem cell donations were completed across India - a powerful testament to DATRI's mission of saving lives. Among these, a remarkable 42 donations came from Andhra Pradesh and Telangana alone, thanks to the tireless efforts of Ravi Chava, supported ably by Praveen and Rajkiran.
